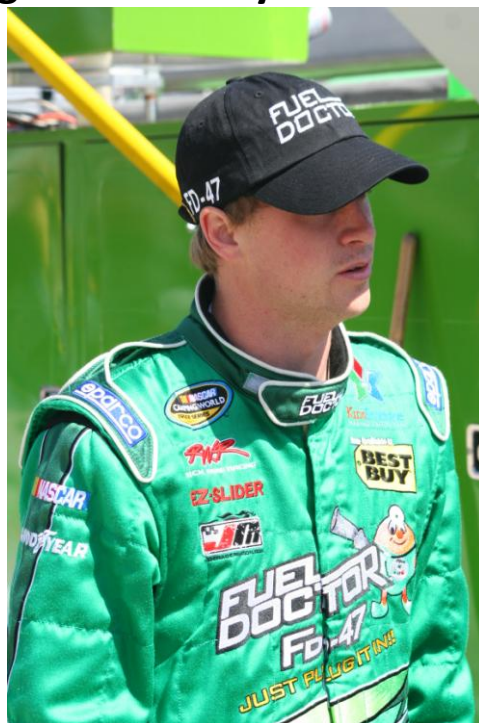

Butler fights adversity to finish 19th at Texas



Brett Butler had a weekend he won't forget anytime soon. During the first practice at Texas Motor Speedway for the WinStar World Casino 400K, Butler lost an engine. The Rick Ware Racing team went to work and replaced it but the close time schedule between practices was not enough to turn a lap during the second practice with the new power plant under the hood.

Butler then grabbed the wheel of the #47 Fuel Doctor USA Chevy and qualified in 23rd but had to start at the rear of the race due to the engine change.

Starting 36th is no easy task and Butler had to maneuver his way through traffic as quickly as possible. By lap twenty, Butler had moved into the 19th position when an unexpected stop was needed. The #47 Fuel Doctor USA Chevy had lost power steering, making it difficult to handle the high speeds of Texas.

Brett returned to the track and continued to put down fast laps to finish in the 19th position, his second highest finish of the season.

“This was a true battle for us with all the adversity we faced today. The guys never gave up and we came out respectable and ready for the next race,” stated Butler.

Many were impressed with Brett’s fortitude today, including Rick Ware. “This kid gets better each and every week. His development is growing rapidly and he will be contending for wins before the season ends.”

Butler now prepares for the VFW 200 at Michigan International Speedway on Saturday June 12th. Practice for the event will be on Friday the 11th at 10:30am and 1:10 on SPEED with qualifying starting at 9:30am on Saturday on SPEED as well.
