## Butler gets lesson from Monster



Brett Butler, driver of the #47 Fuel Doctor Chevy, learned firsthand, how tough the Monster is at Dover International Speedway. After tying his career high qualifying effort in 22<sup>nd</sup>, Butler took the green flag for the running of the Dover 200 on Friday night.

Just five laps into the event, the 47 Fuel Doctor USA Chevy was spinning down the front stretch and hit the inside wall.

"I got under the 95 of Tim Andrews and when I got back in the gas out of four, it came around on me. I got impatient and it cost us a great finish and a great truck," stated Butler.

The Fuel Doctor crew went to work and got Butler back out on the track, picking up valuable points positions to keep the 47 on track.

“I feel really bad about what happened. It was a rookie mistake that won’t happen again. The truck was really fast in practice and we knew if we bought some time we could finish in the top 10 tonight. We are better than this, I am better than this and we will get the Fuel Doctor Chevy back up there where it belongs.”

Butler and the Rick Ware Racing team now have their hands full for Charlotte.

“It’s been a tough month thus far”, stated Ware. “We wrecked two trucks at Kansas, two trucks at Dover and a Nationwide Series car. Every team goes through slumps like this and now it is our time. The guys are working hard and are committed to getting back up in the top fifteen in points.”
