Brett Butler, driver of the #47 Fuel Doctor Chevy, collected his 2nd highest finish of the year at Charlotte Motor Speedway on Friday night in the 22nd position.

The Georgia native took the green flag at the back of the pack and slow and meticulously picked off positions all night in the North Carolina Education Lottery 200.

“This was not our fastest truck in the fleet but a stable one. We needed to finish. We’ve had fast trucks for the past several weeks, but have not had the finish to show it. Despite the situation, we had a goal for the race and accomplished it!” stated Butler.

“It’s been a rough start to the season, but every week our trucks and drivers are getting better. It’s a long season and there is still time to charge back to the front,” stated owner Rick Ware.
