

Stanton Barrett drives for safety in #41 Kids Embrace at Darlington



Stanton Barrett has a date with the Lady in Black, also known as Darlington Raceway, this weekend in the NASCAR Nationwide series Rick Ware Racing (RWR) #41 Kids Embrace Chevy.

Kids Embrace, maker of the convertible child safety seat, is the primary sponsor, and Barrett, who designs, directs, and executes crash scenes for top Hollywood films, understands the importance of using the proper safety restraint system.

“It’s the construction of the seat and restraint system that allows me to perform these crash scenes and walk away. I constantly preach safety on the set, and I’m excited to bring the same message to NASCAR fans for our sponsor Kids Embrace,” Barrett said.

The message of child safety hits close to home for the RWR family. A friend of the team was killed in a car accident last week in High Point, North Carolina. He was not wearing a safety belt.

“With the recent loss to the RWR family, I want to go to Darlington and not only stress the importance of using the proper restraint system for children, but I want to encourage adults to wear their seatbelts. It’s the most important factor to saving your life in a car accident,” Barrett said.

The NASCAR Nationwide series, Royal Purple 200 at the Darlington Raceway is scheduled to start this Friday at 7:30 pm/et.
